I am to give a talk at the Judges Forum in February next year about judges' comments on test sheets, and I am seeking feedback from all PRARG, Cedar Grove, RASDEC members (and any other clubs you have email contact with), to assist me to provide an informative and amusing segment. **See above. Please note: the information provided to me will be completely confidential and no names will be used in the presentation.**

I would really like any riders who have had comments made on their test sheets that:

1. are amusing - "*horse funny behind*"
2. incomprehensible/ confusing - "*horse rolls too much*"
3. not helpful - "*curb chain too tight*"
4. rude "*rider should give horse to someone else to ride*", or
5. any other comments the rider had problems with understanding etc and wants clarification
6. any suggestions riders/coaches/ judges have that might be of assistance or wish discussed.

These comments will be de-identified so no one will know where they came from, but the purpose is to make the judges more aware of the terms they use and the impact of the comments they make on the riders. It would be helpful to know what level the test was being ridden at (Novice? Advanced? FEI?) and the movement (at E circle right 15 metres), the mark (0-10) and the comment (curb chain too tight) that were made/ given.

If riders have a term that a judge has used which they think could be better said to provide clarity, and they have a suggestion with regard to how they think it could be improved that would be great.

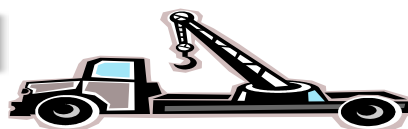
