THE DRESSAGE COACHES:



Jacqui Huppert is a Grand Prix (GP) Rider, a NCAS Level 2 Specialist Dressage Coach, an 'A' level GP and Young Horse Dressage Judge and Judge Mentor. Jacqui has been a member of the EQ State Dressage Squad on "QEB Jinglebell Swing", "QEB King of Swing", and "QEB Bolero", and is now competing successfully on "Cognac Diamond" (picture). Jacqui concentrates on the rider's position and effectiveness of the aids to maximise the potential of the horse/rider combination. Jacqui believes in creating suppleness and elasticity in both horse and rider to improve the fluidity of the combination and their ability to ride in harmony together.

She coaches from beginners through to elite level including the Dressage World Championships preparation in 2018, and the Eventing Olympic Selection Campaign in 2024, along with State Squad Senior and Youth Riders. Ricky stays up to date with trips to Germany and the U.K and working with international coaches. Ricky focuses on supporting riders to enjoy their journey of learning how to best guide and develop their horses. She emphasizes autonomy of horse and rider, while following the International "Scale of Training" with a ready willingness to adapt to the needs of each rider and horse. She enjoys helping riders discover how best to help their horses to make good choices.
