## ON PROPOSED NEW BY LAW AS BELOW

The management committee for awhile has been discussing how to deal with any members and/or coaches that do not follow the requirements of the club when it comes to use of the grounds regarding use of keys, allowing non-members to ride on the grounds, use of uninsured coaches as a few examples. Below is a proposed new By Law. This will be voted on at the June meeting – Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> June at 6.30pm. Members are welcome to attend if they have any input or thoughts.

- 1<sup>st</sup> warning – verbal
- 2<sup>nd</sup> warning – written
- 3<sup>rd</sup> warning – At the discretion of the management committee. This penalty can range from loss of key for a period of time to deferring membership for a certain period of time, depending on the severity of the infringement.
- Committee to keep a record

- Any person or persons who harass a judge or steward shall be deemed guilty of unseemly conduct and may be disqualified for the remainder of the show with all awards forfeited.
- PRARG Inc reserves the right to reduce or cancel any advertised prizes through lack of competition and also to substitute any advertised prize money with goods or trophies. PRARG Inc reserves the right to award sashes only or any prizes for Championships and Reserves for classes on the day.
- PRARG Inc reserves the right to amend the programme without notification should circumstances warrant this action.
