Message from the President

- PRARG continues to welcome many new and renewing members through February/ March and to meeting 13.04.22. The first ribbon day for the year on 22nd March was almost like an open day with so many members riding but still had the relaxed and quiet feel around the grounds with lots of social interacting happening which was the key of the day. All members were able to access yards with a bit of juggling.
- As we know by now PRARG was lucky after the floods but not so many of our fellow equestrian clubs in LCC. To this end PRARG has offered on a trial three month basis (May/June/July) to loan the grounds at no charge to Jimboomba Carriage Driving whose grounds are not usable and may be that way for awhile. We hope this will have minimal impact on our members by picking i.e. Saturday afternoon or a Sunday morning not being used for clinics or competitions. This will be well advertised prior to the commencement. In addition, PRARG has agreed to donate \$250 to the Lismore floods, specifically going to veterinary facilities looking after flood affected horses and \$200 to the QLD Cancer Council after the Fun Day.
- Grounds—PRARG was successful in gaining a grant for maintenance of the logs arounds the arenas. Unfortunately the initial work involved being at the grounds when riders were around but within safety reasons. After Easter the grounds will be closed for the final work which requires use of chain saws etc. There is also a fence to be erected in front of the lunge yard with a gate to maintain safety of horses especially during competitions that are being lunged and/or tied to float if in the event of a mishap they get away.
- The small sub-committee from RASDEG, PRARG and CDG are continuing to meet and fine tune what should be an amazing OTT series in 2022 which will be held July, August and September..
- **Clinics – Thanks to EQ for \$1000 towards the Super clinic 18/4, Pole Clinic 23/4 and K. Battista clinic 2/5. The acknowledgement re clinics is elsewhere in newsletter.**
- Due to family and personal reason Lorraine Edwards is stepping down from being vice president but will continue in a limited way with scoring and helping where possible. The club regretfully accepted her resignation as Lorraine has been a major backbone of the club for many years. Leanne Smith accepted the VP vacancy at the meeting on 13.04.22. A new committee position will be advertised soon.

IMPORTANT RULES TO FOLLOW AT PRARG GROUNDS

The expectation from our Management Committee, Insurance Provider, Logan Council and Equestrian Australia is to ensure that only financial members of PRARG and registered competitors are permitted to ride on the grounds. To maintain our excellent reputation as a compliant and diligent club this warning reminder is stated:

Do not allow your friends or other persons to ride your horse while on the grounds. A coach may but must have either EA insurance or their own a certificate of currency.

There are no exceptions from this ruling and a serious penalty process will apply to anyone who jeopardises the rule. The rules we apply are to protect, one and all, so we expect that you will understand and respect this warning.

INSURANCE

As a rider at PRARG, unless you are a **FINANCIAL** member of **Equestrian Australia (via EQ)**, you are **NOT** covered for personal injury should you have a fall at the grounds.

You are covered **24/7** for personal injury as an EA member when you ride. This benefit alone should be reason enough to join, either as a supporter, recreational, participant or competitor.

A Property Identification Code (PIC) is used by Biosecurity Queensland and is unique to your property.

This code is necessary for maintaining property and livestock records as part of the National Livestock Identification System (NLIS).

These requirements:

- Protect our livestock industries from pests and diseases
- Provide a system for individual or group identification if your stock are removed from your property
- Allow you to record individual performance data for management and breeding purposes.

All Queensland properties that have livestock, such as cattle and horses, must have a PIC number.

If you have not already provided PRARG with your PIC number when joining or renewing your membership, please email this through to prarg.membership@gmail.com

Failure to register your property can result in a \$4,000 fine.

Verification of Low-Risk status is required for ALL DESTINATIONS of those using the Self-certification ROM for a low-risk movement. By definition, low-risk land status can ONLY be verified by the owner/person responsible for managing the use of that land. Low-risk status cannot be verified by horse owners for NSW destinations, unless they are the owner/person responsible for managing the use of that land. NSW Border Compliance Officers audit all self-certified movements and may request a written copy of land status verification.

Declaring a low-risk movement on your ROM without this verification is a false declaration and subject to penalties and enforcement action as stated on the ROM.

Unfortunately, some horse owners have been self-certifying movements to verified low-risk NSW destinations, then engaging in high-risk activities and visiting high-risk land during their stay in NSW. This is non-compliance and obviously outside the Risk Management intent of low-risk land status.

Generally, trail riding is deemed a high-risk activity as it involves a property or properties with status undetermined or in question. Wherever NSW destination status is in doubt, those wishing to self-certify should directly contact a manager at NSW DPI Cattle Tick Operations in order to identify the risk status OR to demonstrate sufficient risk control measures for the DPI to accept that location as low-risk.

FOR RIDERS COMING FROM NSW, PRARG'S PIC NO IS QGBD2529. The grounds do not have cattle on them. If you require spraying going back to NSW you will need to leave the grounds by 2.30 to get back to the border to be sprayed. There are sprayers in Beaudesert which can be organised by prior arrangement.

IMPORTANT

Lunging at PRARG



- 1. Lunging in the 10 minute box will be permitted when the PRARG grounds are not being otherwise utilised for competitions, clinics or other such events. One rider lunging then riding, in the 10 minute box for a limited time, on these days, could be allowed under extenuating circumstances when horse and rider safety is an issue.*
- 2. If a member wishes to use the 10 minute box to ride their horse, the rider takes precedence over a member wishing to lunge their horse; noting that there is a designated lunging yard / area available for use by members.*
- 3. However, if a member is already lunging their horse in the 10 minute box, then the rider wishing to use the 10 minute box will wait until the lunging has been completed before entering. Lunging and riding at the same time in the 10 minute box is not encouraged but may occur with the consent of both parties - all parties acknowledging the waivers they have signed as PRARG members, and acting in a responsible and practicable manner.*
- 4. If at any time any or all parties using the 10 minute box, feels unsafe, all parties should act in the best interests of both horse and rider welfare.*
- 5. As per the PRARG Code of Conduct, it is expected that all members are courteous and considerate when communicating with others and reasonable and practical in their actions, at all times.*

Members breaching the Code of Conduct may be sanctioned.
