Conditions for Off the Track Classes	
Membership for the OTT classes	Riders must be a financial members of PRARG to be eligible for entry.
	OTT riders will be placed in separate classes and will be eligible for the OTT awards as well as normal PRARG trophy points.
Prizes – OTT classes ONLY	Rosettes 1 st to 3 rd each class
	Judges Choice Rosette (Sponsored by Monarch Farms) over the three days.
	To be eligible for Champion rugs at Preparatory, Preliminary, Novice, Elementary, Medium/ Advanced the horse and rider combination must have completed at least 2 legs of the PRARG QOTT dressage series as part of the PRARG ribbon days and achieved the highest points as per EA rules.
	Champion of each level will receive a rug and two lessons of their choice from QOTT coaches – Jacqui Huppert, Gary Lung or Jeanette Bourke.
	Reserve champion of each level will receive an embroidered bridle bag and one lesson of their choice from QOTT coaches – Jacqui Huppert, Gary Lung or Jeanette Bourke
Eligibility of horses	Horses must have been named within the relevant racehorse stud book. For example; thoroughbreds must be registered to the Australian Studbook All OTT entries must include the appropriate registered name (e.g. Race Name). Please ensure that your horse's registered name is included in your nomination, failure to do so may result in ineligibility. Any entry that does not include the correct OTT registered name will have their entry changed to an open class entry.
