Series Reserve Champion per level – Embroidered Bridle bag and 1 x Lesson with QOTT approved Coach.

Individual series leg classes - Rosettes 1st to 3rd

Restricted and Open Classes - Ribbons 1st - 10th (Dressage) 1st – 4th (Hacks)

Dress – As from 1.8.2021 - Members can wear black or navy breeches/jodhpurs instead of the current requirement for white, cream or beige / Members can wear a long sleeve polo shirt in the club colours (i.e. light blue), instead of a PRARG club shirt if they prefer to have long sleeves, or they can wear sun sleeves with their club shirt for sun protection or otherwise normal EA riding gear. All riders must wear approved headgear. If you are not sure, please contact Kay (prarginc81@bigpond.com) for clarification.

GENERAL: Run under EA rules (2023), EA tests (2023) and PRARG By-Laws concerning ownership of mounts. Vet/medical certificate must be received within 7 days of the event for a refund. Dressage – Horses must compete within their EA grading or compete HC. A maximum number of tests is 2 and only 2 consecutive levels may be ridden (competitively including freestyles). Test Evaluation is a non-competitive test. All FEI tests will be as per the EA/ EQ website. Freestyles – as per current EA amendments. The day will be run under current COVID-19 guidelines.

RESTRICTED CLASSES

Class 13 - No Canter (Prep 1) **Saddle type optional (not western) Restricted to *the rider's principal source of income must not be obtained from sponsorship, breeding, breaking or training, riding and/or coaching any horse or rider. If so, the rider needs to ride HC.***

Class 14 - No canter (Prep 2) **Saddle type optional (not western)**

Class 15 - Test 1.1 – **Restricted to *the rider's principal source of income must not be obtained from sponsorship, breeding, breaking, or training, riding and/or coaching any horse or rider. If so, the rider needs to ride HC.***

Class 16 - Test 1.2 – Restricted to horses not entered in Classes 17 & 18 with the same restrictions as Class 15.

Hack Definitions:

Maiden – Not to have won a 1st at an individual hack event including ribbon days.

Novice – Never won an open Championship.

Intermediate – Never to have a won a 1st in an open class.

Open - ** Points scored go towards **club perpetual award**.

Rider - ** as per trophy list – points towards **club perpetual award**

Conditions for Queensland Off the Track Classes	
Membership for the QOTT classes	Riders must be financial members of PRARG to be eligible for entry. QOTT riders will be placed in separate classes and will be eligible for the QOTT awards as well as normal PRARG trophy points. When entering QOTT classes please indicate if you will be entry will be equivalent open or restricted classes (i.e., 1.1 in restricted or open section) for PRARG end of year awards.
Prizes – QOTT classes ONLY	Sashes or rosettes 1 st to 3 rd each class, Series Champion trophy rug and coaching vouchers. Series Reserve Champion bridle bag and coaching voucher. To be eligible for Champion rugs at Preparatory, Preliminary, Novice, Elementary, Medium/Advanced, the horse and rider combination must have completed at least 2 legs of the PRARG QOTT dressage series as part of the PRARG ribbon days and achieved the highest points as per EA rules.
Eligibility of horses	Horses must have been named within the relevant racehorse stud book or Harness racing stud book. For example, thoroughbred horses must be registered to the Australian Studbook (NOT just EA). All QOTT entries must include the appropriate registered name (e.g., Race Name of the horse entered). Please ensure that your horse's registered name is included in your nomination, failure to do so may result in ineligibility for QOTT awards and prizes. Any entry that does not include the correct QOTT registered name (thoroughbred or standardbred) will have their entry changed to an open class entry.
