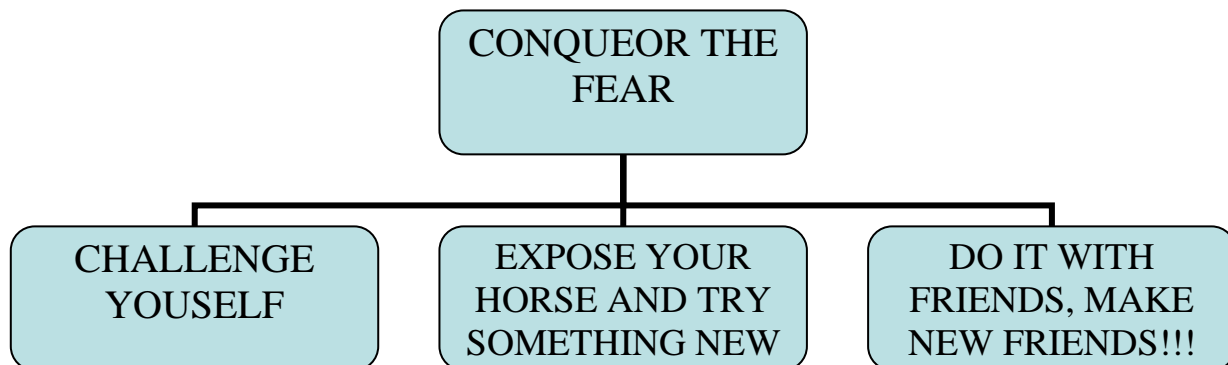


PARK RIDGE ACTIVE RIDING GROUP INC

ENTRIES CLOSE: Thursday 18th May 2023 at 5pm. **NUMBERS WILL BE CAPPED AT 60 AND A RESERVE KEPT.**

ENTRY FEE: \$20 per class / \$5 aid levy / Teams – no additional entry fee. **ENTRIES WILL BE CAPPED AT 60 AND A RESERVE KEPT TO MAKE THE DAY MANAGEABLE WITH PARKING.**

DRESS RULES: **Dress rules will be relaxed for riders entered within a Team and can wear elected Team Colours (including saddlepads/bandages).** If not riding as part of a team, the club day dress rules apply – i.e. black or navy breeches/jodhpurs instead of white, cream or beige if desired. Members can also wear a long sleeve polo shirt in the club colours (light blue), instead of a PRARG club shirt if they prefer to have long sleeves, or they can wear sun sleeves with their club shirt for sun protection. Otherwise, riders can wear standard EA competition dress. **All riders** must wear approved headgear and footwear.

GENERAL: Run under EA Rules (2023) and PRARG By Laws concerning ownership of mounts. **Vet/medical certificate must be received within 7 days of the event for refund** (less 25% to cover costs). Horses must compete within their EA grading or compete HC. Riders may only enter two classes on the day. Maximum number of classes per horse/rider combination is two & only two consecutive levels may be ridden. Maximum number of horses per rider is two. In the case of cancellation of the event, 25% may be retained per rider by the club.

PRIZES:

- Ribbons 1st to 10th all classes / Ribbons 3rd to 10th for placing teams
- Rosette for Winning Team and Reserve Team (judged by highest aggregate scores of 4 riders' scores from their 2 tests ridden)
- Rosette for Judges choice per ring
- Sashes for: **Best Team Name | Best Team Colours | Best Team Spirit**

TEAM FORMAT

Riders to form a Team prior to the event. The information required on the entry form will include:

- Yours and your horse's name
- Name of your Team (select Class 14 in addition to your test classes) you wish to be in.
- If you don't know other members of PRARG to form a team with, you can choose to be part of a composite team (select Class 15 in addition to your test classes)
- Teams to consist of **4 riders (best 3 scores to count)**. Riders can ride any level they are eligible for, and levels can be mixed within the team, e.g. two riders at prelim & novice and one rider at medium & advanced. Riders best 3 scores will be added together and highest aggregate over all tests for the team will decide the Team Winner and Team Reserve.
